## Location

Avarest House is situated in the popular coastal resort of Portrush. Our central location on the Causeway Coast means that there is a very short driving time to and from the major attractions of this beautiful area. A small selection of local attractions is shown below

### Dunluce Castle 5 minute drive

This is the largest and most romantic castle of its type in Northern Ireland. Its history dates back to 500AD and the visitor centre on-site tells its story.



### Old Bushmills Distillery A further 10 minute drive

The oldest legal distillery in the world - offering guided tours through various stages of whiskey production.



### The Giants Causeway A further 5 minute drive

Probably one of the most famous landmarks in the area, this world famous attraction has been deemed a world heritage site.



### Carrick-a-rede A further 15 minute drive

Famous for its salmon fishery and rope bridge. Crossing the bridge is for those who dare but the views from this area are magnificent.



## Ballintoy Harbour

10 minute drive

Ballintoy is steeped in history and folklore. The area around Ballintoy is exceptional for walking and the scenery is nothing short of stunning



### From Belfast International Airport

Take the route A26 north through Antrim, then by-pass Ballymena on the M2 joining the A26 again by-passing Ballymoney to Coleraine. Take the route A29 to Portrush.

### From Belfast City Airport

Take the North route on the M5/M2 until junction 1. Then take A26 north.

### From Larne Harbour

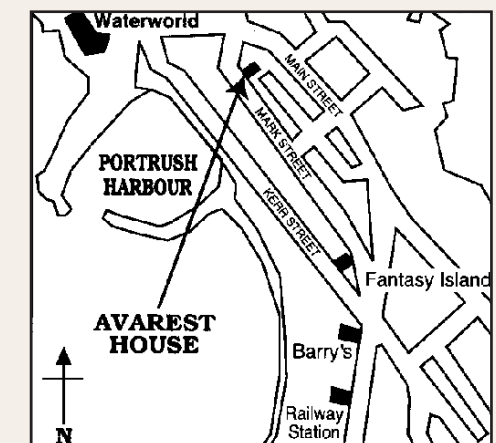
Leave Larne on the A8 for 3 miles and then take the route A36 to Ballymena. Follow the M2/A26 north to Coleraine.

### From City of Derry

Take route A2 east to Limavady, then A37 to Coleraine and then A29 towards Portrush.

### Already in Portrush

Follow one way system, taking town centre signs. At steep hill at Harbour turn right. At crossroads take another right turn. Avarest is located first left after Counties Apartments.
